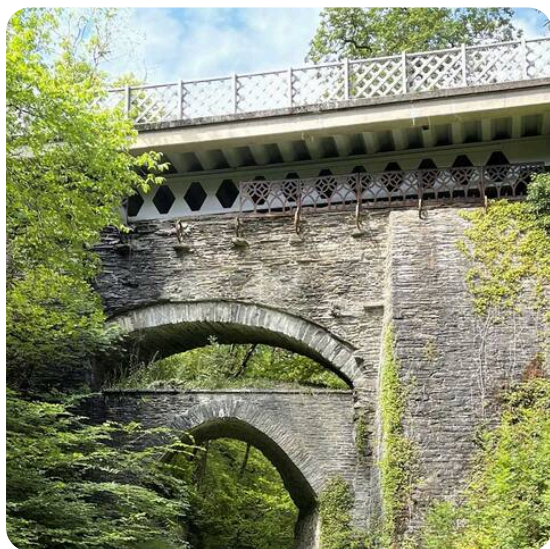
## Sightseeing

76 locals recommend

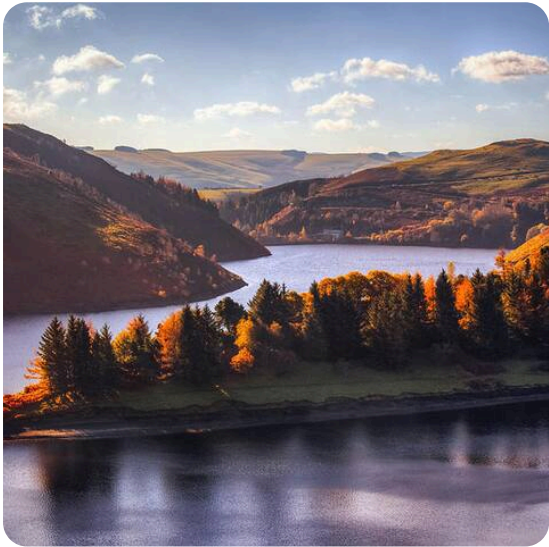
Walk down the steep steps to see the 3 bridges and the waterfalls.

176 locals recommend

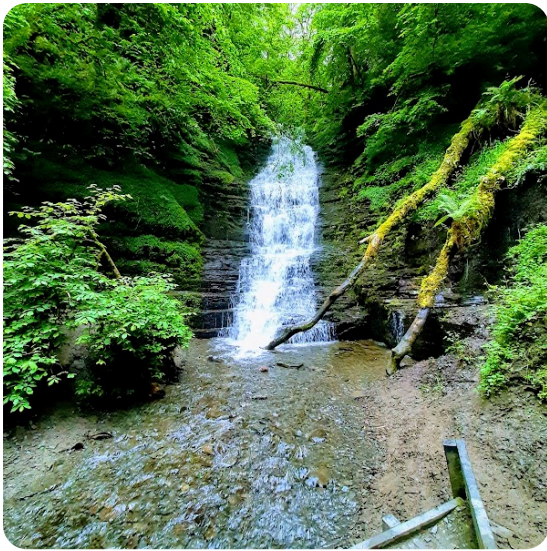
it's just under a 2 hour drive but a beautiful place to visit

25 locals recommend

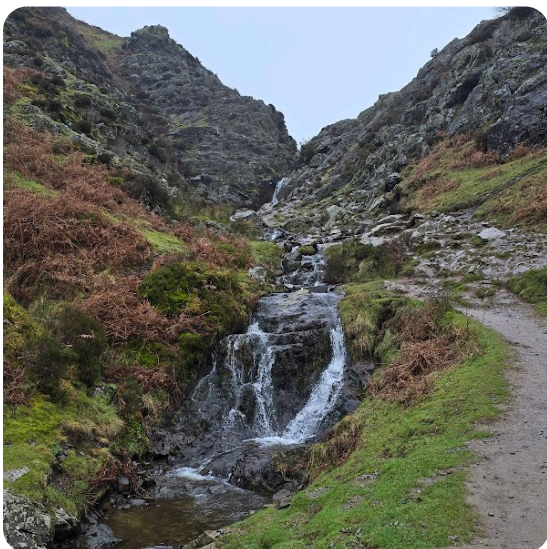
a waterfall which is only a short walk from the carpark. it's usually quite quiet here and peaceful
