Security & Doors

The key safe code is 2018, please leave the key in the key safe when you go out and finally leave the cottage at the end of your stay. To lock the door, you will need to lift the handle and turn the key to lock it. This also applies when you lock the door internally. The windows are Tilt and Turn windows and if you move the handle upwards to a 90-degree setting you will be able to open the tops of the windows, move all the way to the top to open the window fully. There are Velux windows upstairs and you will need to pull the handle to release the lock, then you can pull and open the window.



Smoking

This is a strictly no smoking site.



Parking

Please Park in the parking space at the rear of the cottage. The lane is very quiet, however, please do take care when exiting the parking space. When leaving it is better to head out past the front of the cottage as this takes you to the main road between Llanidloes and Rhayader and is the quickest and easiest route to take to get to other destinations.



Kitchen

Whilst the kitchen is compact you have the essentials to make delicious meals. You will find all your crockery, pots and pans, glasses etc in the corner base unit. Basic cleaning equipment, draining board etc under the sink. The Hob is induction, and the pans and casserole dish are suitable for use on this. We have provided some Welsh, Tea, Coffee, and Hot Chocolate for you to enjoy together with milk and some Welsh Cakes.



Bedroom

The bedroom has all you should need for storing your clothes, please note there is a hanging rail attached to the original beam in the bedroom area if you need to hang any clothes, together with cast iron, rams head hooks for longer items. The Bedside lights are touch operated and have USB ports for charging phones etc. There is a led mirror on the dressing table which is touch controlled and a hairdryer is stored in the chest of drawers.

Your fresh towels are stored in the Chest of Drawers.

The thermostat for the heating is up here, we have set this to provide a comfortable temperature of 20 degrees during the day, and 16 degrees at night, you can press the plus or minus button to change this.

We do ask that if you are bringing pets that they remain downstairs.



Living Room

We have installed a smart tv and it is also connected to Free Sat (Freeview).

If you wish to log in to you own Netflix (etc) accounts please feel free, however, please log out at the end of your stay. The controls and instruction manuals are all stored in the drawer under the TV. We have provided some basic games and books together with some local tourist information.

We do ask that if you are bringing pets that if they are to sit on the sofa that a blanket is put down first.



Dining Area

Our dining area is a snug and cosy area for you to sit and eat, the coasters and placemats are left on the table, so no hunting around for anything. We have placed a freestanding lamp in the area with a foot button on the floor should you need any extra lighting.



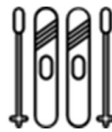
Shower Room

Our shower room has everything you need, including shower gel, and is run using an external pump. Please note that the water is heated and stored in an immersion tank so please be mindful of how long you shower for.



Outdoors & Furniture

We have an enclosed front garden with two-seater bistro set and the rear garden has a picnic bench and festoon lights which come on automatically 1 hour before sunset and turn off at 11pm. The rear garden is not enclosed, there are hooks located around the garden where you can secure your pet if you want to sit in the rear garden with them.



Miscellaneous

Blinds for Velux windows, to operate these you need to push up the bar at the bottom of the blind, this releases the lock mechanism, and you can then adjust the blind to how you want it.

Extractor fans, the Kitchen extractor fan is manually operated using a pull cord. We ask that when cooking you turn this on to help remove excess steam and smells. The bathroom one is automatic.

We have an ironing board, iron and airing rack available, however, we keep these in our storeroom. If you think you will need these just let us know.

Dogs, we have provided a basket with some dog essentials, just in case you have forgotten to bring anything. In the basket we have spare bowls, poop bags, some treats, a long line lead (can be used in the rear garden), blanket, spare towels. Please keep your dog on lead when around the farm and when walking locally.



Rubbish / Recycling

We have provided a rubbish bin in the kitchen which should be more than enough for rubbish and recycling during your stay. We will separate the recycling upon your check out. In addition, there is a small bin in the bathroom for Bathroom waste and one in the bedroom for incidental rubbish. If you find you have filled your bins during your stay and they need emptying, please drop us a message and we will remove the rubbish for you.

When checking out please ensure that you lock the front door and that the windows are all closed, please leave the key in the keysafe.
Please leave all towels in the shower room.

Surrounding Areas



Supermarkets

Our nearest supermarkets are in Llanidloes or Rhayader, where you have the choice of Co-op or Spar. Parking at Llanidloes for these two stores is easier. For large supermarkets, Newtown offers, Tesco, Morrisons, Aldi, Lidl & Iceland and Llandrindrod Wells offers Tesco & Morrisons.

Llanidloes also has 2 bakeries, a Fish Monger, Butcher & Green Grocers, and the closest Petrol station.



Restaurants & Bars

Rhayader has lots of pubs and most serve food. There are several cafes and takeaways.

Llanidloes has fewer pubs but most serve food, there are also 2 indian Restaurants, The Trewethen Restaurant and several cafes and takeaways.

Trefelgwys – Arthurs Restaurant

Typically, Starters range between £5 - £9, Mains £14- £20, Desserts £5 - £9

Drinks – Pint £3.50 - £5.50

Caersws Fish & Chip shop has recently been voted one of the best, not only in Wales but the UK!



Public Transportation

Our nearest train station is Caersws. This is on the line between Shrewsbury and Aberystwyth. You can, with a change at Machynlleth carry on along the coast to Pwelli. The line is classed as one of the most scenic.

Trains from Llandrindod Wells run between Shrewsbury down to Swansea.

Buses are available from Llani to Shrewsbury and Aberystwyth.

There are limited Taxi services around.



Local Attractions

There is so much to do, but it depends on how far you want to travel.

From the cottage

We are fortunate enough to be surrounded by bridle ways and footpaths and only a couple of miles away is part of the Glyndwr Way. We have forests nearby for hiking and Llanidloes and Rhayader are about 10-15 minutes away.

Around 30 minutes

Elan Valley – go to the visitor centre for a coffee and find out about the Elan Valley, they work you way around by car to visit each Dam, or park up and go for a walk. Perfect Scenery all year round!

Hafren Forest – go to the centre of the forest and park up, there are set walking routes which are sign posted or just explore. Walk to the source of the River Severn.

Clywedog Reservoir – Right by the Hafren Forest – lots of walking routes or just drive around it.

Under 1 Hour

Devils Bridge – Visit Devils Bridge and walk to the bottom of the falls. A lovely pub waits for you at the top. You can get here from the Elan Vally by taking the mountain road to Aberystwyth. You can also get the steam train to Aber from here!

Bwlch Nant yr Arian Forest visitor centre – This is on the way to Aberystwyth and is perfect for hiking or off road cycling. They also feed Red Kites here.

Welshpool – Town centre and Powis Castle – Coed-y-dinas garden centre – Steam train trips are just outside Welshpool.

1 -1.5 hours

Aberystwyth – Lovely seaside town, with lots to see and do. Travel further down the cost to Aberaeron and New Quay!

Shrewsbury – Historic market Town, lots of shops, restaurants, and things to do.

Brecon Beacons – climb Pen y Fan or some of the towns around the beacons, including Abergavenny.

Snowdonia National Park – explore Snowdonia national park and the coast.

Health and Safety

Private wate supply – our water supply was tested by Powys County Council on 12th April 2024

Gas Safety – No Gas appliances are used and therefore no Carbon Monoxide alarms are in use.

Fire Safety – 2 Smoke alarms are fitted in the cottage. A fire extinguisher is available. Please ensure that the oven and hob are turned off when not in use and that nothing is left on the hob when not in use.

First Aid – A first aid kit is kept in the kitchen with basic supplies should you need them.

Septic Tank – The toilet empties into a septic tank. Please only flush soft tissue down the toilet.
